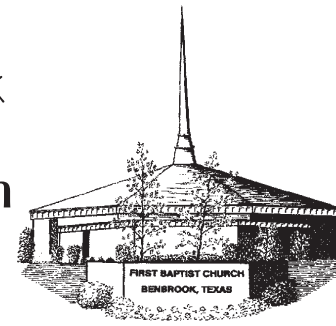

## The Pastor's Pen

This Sunday, we will share the Lord's Supper together in our Joint Worship service at 11 AM. As you prepare yourself for worship, I invite you to read 1 Corinthians 11.17-34. In this passage, the apostle chastised the believers in Corinth for their "coming together" because of the divisions among them. Because they ate the bread and drank the cup but did not "discern the body," they invited the Lord's judgment and discipline upon them, judgment that was so severe that many of them were weak, sick, and some even died.

We should not miss this incredible warning. The "body" the church was to discern was the body of Christ, His church. If we partake in the Lord's Table but fail to realize that we are causing a breach of fellowship in the body of Christ, then we so offend the Savior who died to unite the church into one body that His judgment is unleashed in frightening ways.

So, as you prepare for worship this weekend, please consider praying this simple prayer: "Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against thee in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved thee with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. For the sake of thy Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in thy will, and walk in thy ways, to the glory of thy Name. Amen."

*Sarah's Key* by Tatiana de Rosnay

Paris, July 1942: Sarah, a ten year-old girl, is brutally arrested with her family by the French police in the Vel' d'Hiv' roundup, but not before she locks her younger brother in a cupboard in the family's apartment, thinking that she will be back within a few hours.

Paris, May 2002: On Vel' d'Hiv's 60th anniversary, journalist Julia Jarmond is asked to write an article about this black day in France's past. Through her contemporary investigation, she stumbles onto a trail of long-hidden family secrets that connect her to Sarah. Julia finds herself compelled to retrace the girl's ordeal, from that terrible term in the Vel d'Hiv', to the camps, and beyond. As she probes into Sarah's past, she begins to question her own place in France, and to reevaluate her marriage and her life.

Tatiana de Rosnay offers a brilliantly subtle, compelling portrait of France under occupation and reveals the taboos and silence that surround this painful episode.
