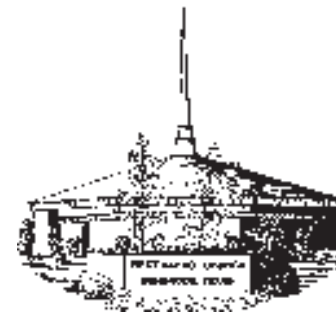

## *The Pastor's Pen*

As I write this article from sunny Minnesota, I would like to begin by thanking my congregation for graciously providing the resources, both in budget money for training conferences and in time away, for me to attend this pastor's conference. In gratitude, I share with you a few thoughts from the first day of the conference.

Paul Tripp began the conference with a study from Malachi 2, and though his words were aimed at a room full of pastors, they apply to all believers in the new covenant. Malachi was speaking to priests, something we have become in Christ, a kingdom of priests. The prophet warned the priests because they did not set their hearts to honor the Lord's name (2.1), they did a poor job of listening to God's voice (2.1), they turned aside from the way (2.8), and they had shown partiality in the law (2.9).

Unfortunately, these priests had a heart problem, and though they were continuing in their priestly duties, their hearts were corrupt. Their ears were dull, and they had grown comfortable with small sins. They treated the law as multiple choice suggestions. And since the priests had gone astray, the people they led were stumbling into darkness.

As a pastor, it was good to be reminded of these things. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to listen.
